NEOM

NEOM

NEOM is planned to be the city of the future in Saudi Arabia. It will adopt new technologies in terms of infrastructure, mobility, housing, media, entertainment, and all aspects of life. After completion, NEOM will be the home and workplace of more than a million citizens and residents.

The project is located in the north-west of Saudi Arabia, overlooking the Red Sea with an area of 26,500Km²

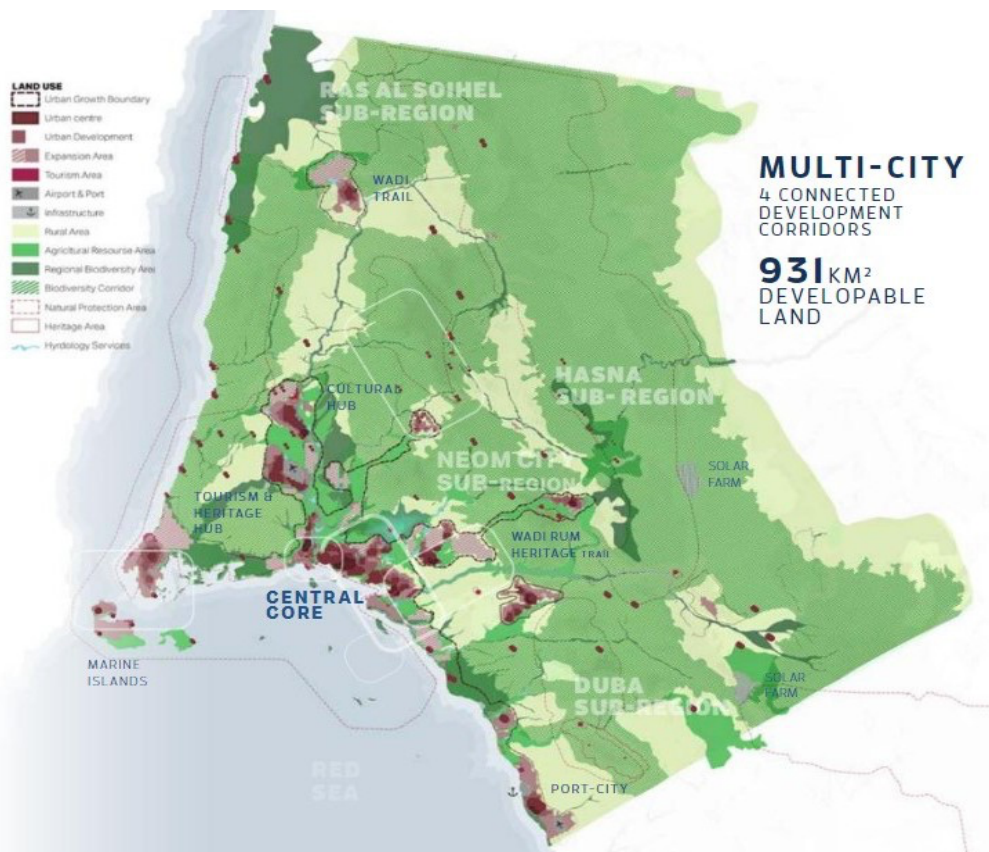


Figure 1- NEOM master plane



Project Cost:

1- The Line

THE LINE, a 170km belt of hyper-connected future communities, without cars and roads and built around nature. A cornerstone of Saudi Vision 2030 and an economic engine for the Kingdom, it will drive diversification and aims to contribute 380,000 jobs in the future and SAR180 billion (USD48 bn) to domestic GDP by 2030. Walkability will define life on THE LINE – all essential daily services, such as schools, medical clinics, leisure facilities, and green spaces, will be within a five-minutewalk.

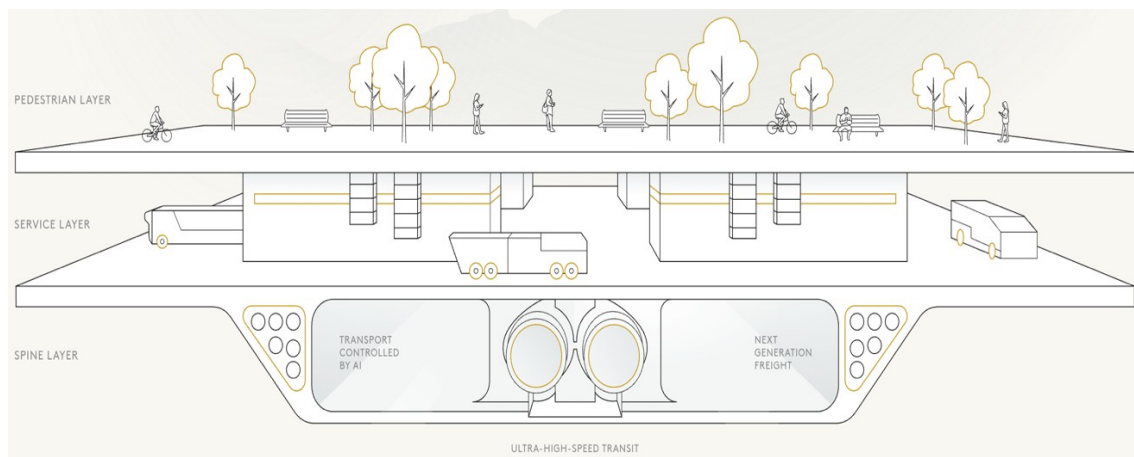


Figure 2- The Line City layers

THE LINE will comprise carbon-positive urban developments powered by 100% clean energy, providing residents with pollution-free, healthier, and more sustainable environments. Mixed-use communities will be built around nature instead of over it.

2- OXAGON

OXAGON is NEOM's economic and industrial engine. The project core development area will be 48 km², designed to attract global talent and bring new life into manufacturing. It's planned to be the largest floating structure in the world and will be powered by 100% clean energy.

OXAGON port will be 7 km long and have a capacity of 3.5 million TEU, which may increase to 9 million TEU by 2030.

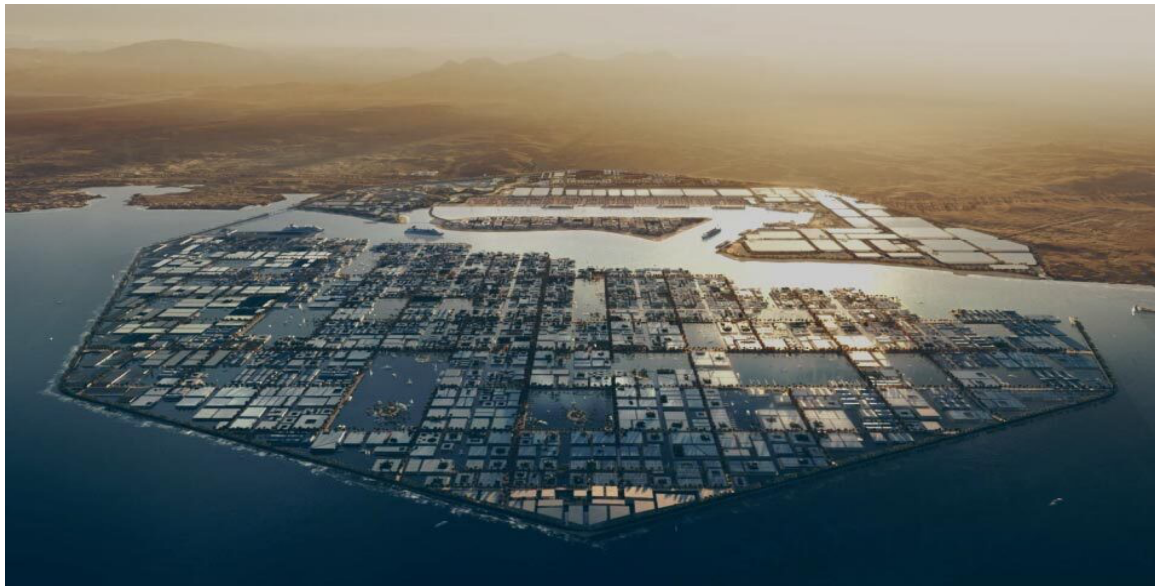


Figure 3- OXAGON INDUSTRIAL CITY

These projects collectively transform the capital into an environmentally friendly, sustainable city that offers the highest livability standards and lifestyle in line with the Kingdom’s Vision 2030 goals.

The Sports Boulevard will encourage the citizens of Riyadh to follow a healthy lifestyle by exercising and participating in different sports, mainly walking, cycling, and horse riding.

The project will include three types of tracks:

1. Pedestrian paths: Extends for 135km
2. Horse riding trails: Extends for 134km
3. Cycling paths: Extends for 220km,

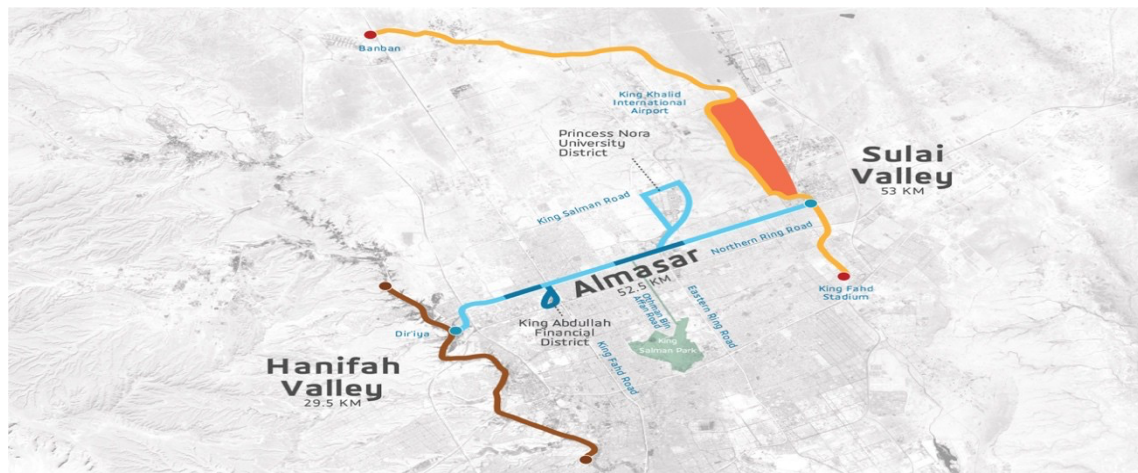


Figure 4 – Sports Boulevard Master plan

RIYADH ART

RIYADH ART

Riyadh Art is one of four Megaprojects being developed by the Royal Commission for Riyadh City (RCRC) that collectively transform the capital into an environmentally friendly, sustainable city offering the highest standards of livability and lifestyle, in line with the Kingdom’s Vision 2030 goals.

The project will include 10 programs and 2 festivals:¹

- 1. Urban Art Lab:** Galleries for well-known artists in city squares that encourage interaction between artists and citizens. Each pavilion will include one digital artwork and cultural programming and is a blend of production atelier, gallery, artist studio, open-air classroom, office, and lecture space. There will be approximately four pavilions, four Interactive artworks, and eight urban locations.
- 2. Riyadh Icon:** This is dedicated to the creation of a 21st-century distinctive icon for the city of Riyadh and Saudi Arabia. This ambitious international commission is a visual symbol of the cultural aspirations of Vision 2030, and it heralds a new era of Saudi intention to celebrate a global community that sparks creativity, ignites the art movement, encourages self-expression, and creates an inclusive culture. One location, one iconic tower.
- 3. Welcoming Gateways:** A series of grand “gates of culture” heralding the entrance to Riyadh as a city of culture. Riyadh’s Welcoming Gateways set the tone for a city where the arts and creativity are essential components of a vibrant and inspiring global city. Approximately 10 locations, 10 iconic gateways.
- 4. Garden City:** This is a sculpture park for the 21st-century, inviting new interpretations of art, technology, and environmental engagement for Riyadh’s residents and visitors. It creates a new environment for experiencing interactive and contemporary art outside of the museum, accessible to all at human scale and a platform for small and medium-sized permanent and temporary outdoor artworks to be programmed as part of the wider park creative experience. One location.
- 5. The Hidden River - The Illuminated Bridges:** Artists illuminate key bridges across the city and highlight not only the structural configuration of their creative canvas but also the bridge itself as a physical, social, and emotional connector within the landscape. A distinctive, vibrant experience for everybody. Approximately 10 bridges.

6. **The Hidden River - Art Trail:** Artists interpret the unique history, heritage, and ecology of the wadis of Riyadh, while promoting the artisanal and artistic spirit of the community. The Hidden River is an art trail exploring and reimagining traditional craft-based techniques. Approximately 5 locations.
7. **Joyous Gardens:** Playgrounds designed by famous artists in neighborhood gardens to encourage creative play as a core part of the healthy and vibrant urban life in Riyadh.
8. **Urban Flow:** Integrates public art into the fabric of the citywide network of pedestrian walkways and footpaths, enticing citizens to experience art and the city on their own terms. Shifting focus from a transport system that privileges the car, the city is transitioning to a new future of public transportation, encouraging its citizens out into the streets and onto the Metro to navigate a city that has become the new creative canvas. Approximately 10 locations, more than 70 elements.
9. **Jewels of Riyadh:** Permanent, large-scale site-specific installations form an ongoing program to enhance public spaces, celebrate cultural heritage, contribute to community building, improve the quality of urban life for residents, and attract international tourism.
10. **Art on the Move:** A series of distinctive large-scale, high-impact, colorful, and kinetic art interventions designed to support the wayfinding experience of Riyadh. Artworks will be integrated into the core infrastructure of the city, such as bridges and overpasses, and placed at grand road and rail intersections to provide a truly joyful everyday experience.
11. **Art in Transit:** This program integrates public art into the core fabric of Riyadh's Metro and BRT bus system to create beautiful and distinctive stations, supported by innovative programs that foster interaction amongst citizens.
12. **Noor Riyadh - Completed:** Noor Riyadh is a new citywide annual festival of light and art that nurtures creativity, promotes talent, and delivers awe-inspiring experiences. The 2021 program unites Saudi and international artists and includes several selected public art installations across Riyadh city; 'Light Upon Light,' a landmark exhibition of light art since the 1960s to the present day; and a diverse program of talks, workshops, and events.
13. **Tuwaiq International Sculpture Symposium - Completed:** Sculptors from around the world coming together to produce a series of permanent public artworks. The entire creative process will be

open and accessible to the public with a program of events, visits, talks, and an opening Gala. The work will be on view for 5 days at the end of the Symposium before moving to an open-air gallery accessible to the public.

KING SALMAN PARK PROJECT

King Salman Park is one of the four Megaprojects to develop Riyadh City. The park is built on more than 16km² to become the largest urban park in the world, offering a wide range of options and quality activities for the city's residents and visitors. It will include vast open green spaces covering more than 11.6km² and one million trees, in addition to the Royal Arts Complex, the National Theater, a 7.2km pedestrian walkway (*loop*), and a "valley" area in the middle of the park surrounded with art and water features. The Park will contribute significantly to increasing the vegetation in the region and raising the rate of per capita green spaces, which will have a direct and positive impact on the quality of the environment and the climate.

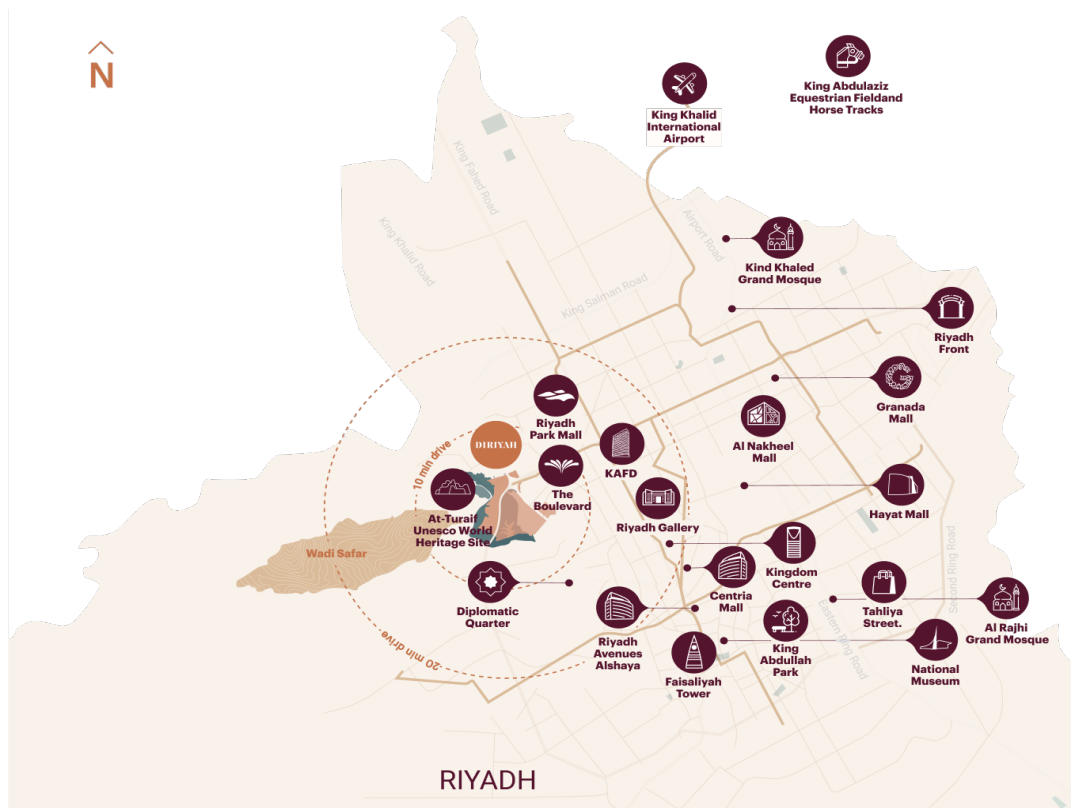


Figure 5 - Diriyah Location

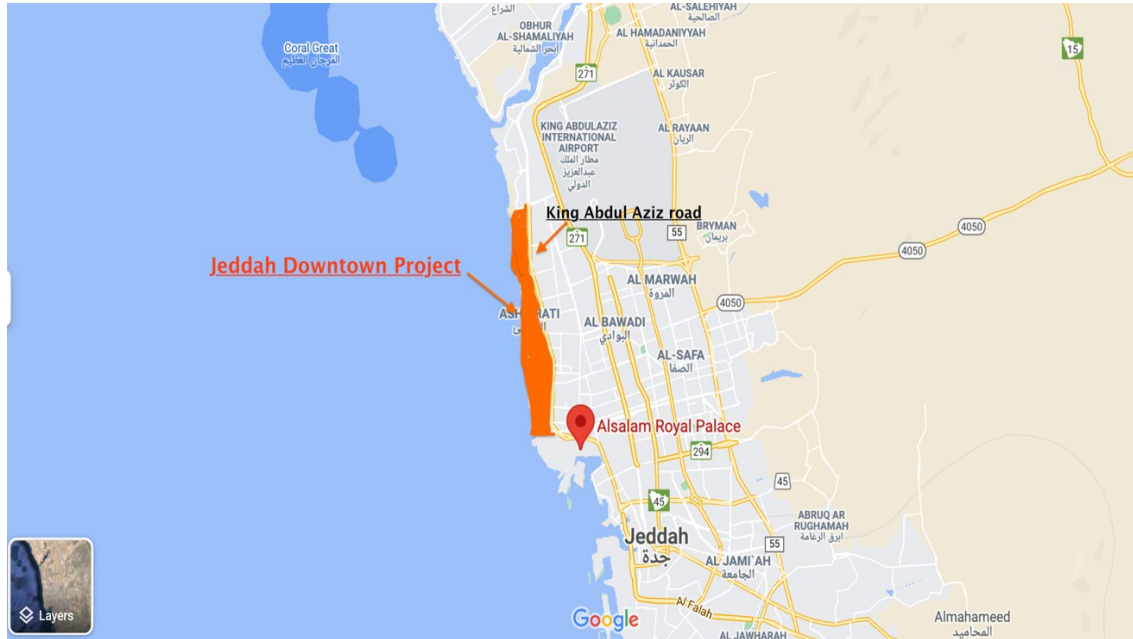


Figure 4 – Jeddah Downtown Location

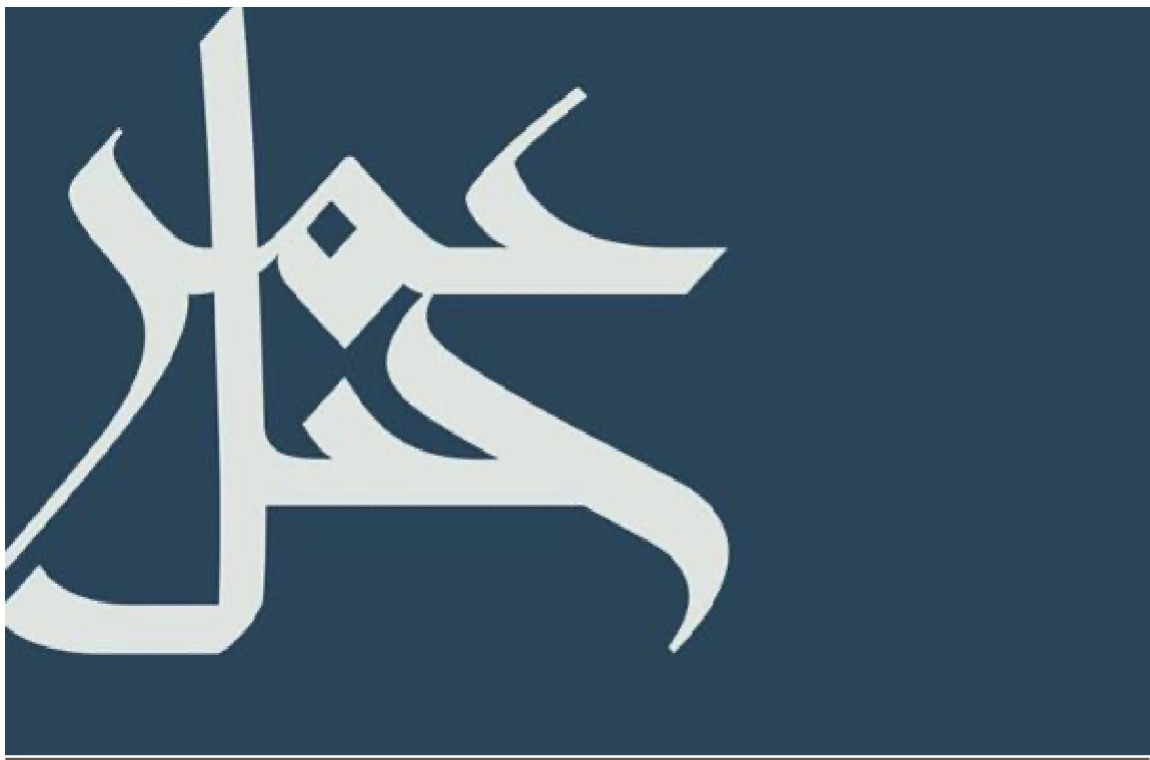

JABAL OMAR

Jabal Omar Project is one of the projects that aim to contribute to achieving Saudi Arabia’s vision 2030 in terms of increasing the annual number of pilgrims to reach 30 million pilgrims by 2030. This target will require massive preparations in terms of infrastructure, hotel, and residential buildings, in addition to basic services such as transportation, energy, medical services, and shopping facilities, all of which must be in-line with the Kingdom’s vision in terms of sustainability.

The project stretches for 235km², with a built area up to 2.5m², and was divided into seven phases. Upon its completion, the project is supposed to offer 38 towers and 16 international hotels in addition to the commercial area.

According to Jabal Omar sources, 100% of phase one was delivered successfully, phases (5-6-7) haven’t been launched yet. As for the rest of the phases, their expected delivery time can be seen in the table below.

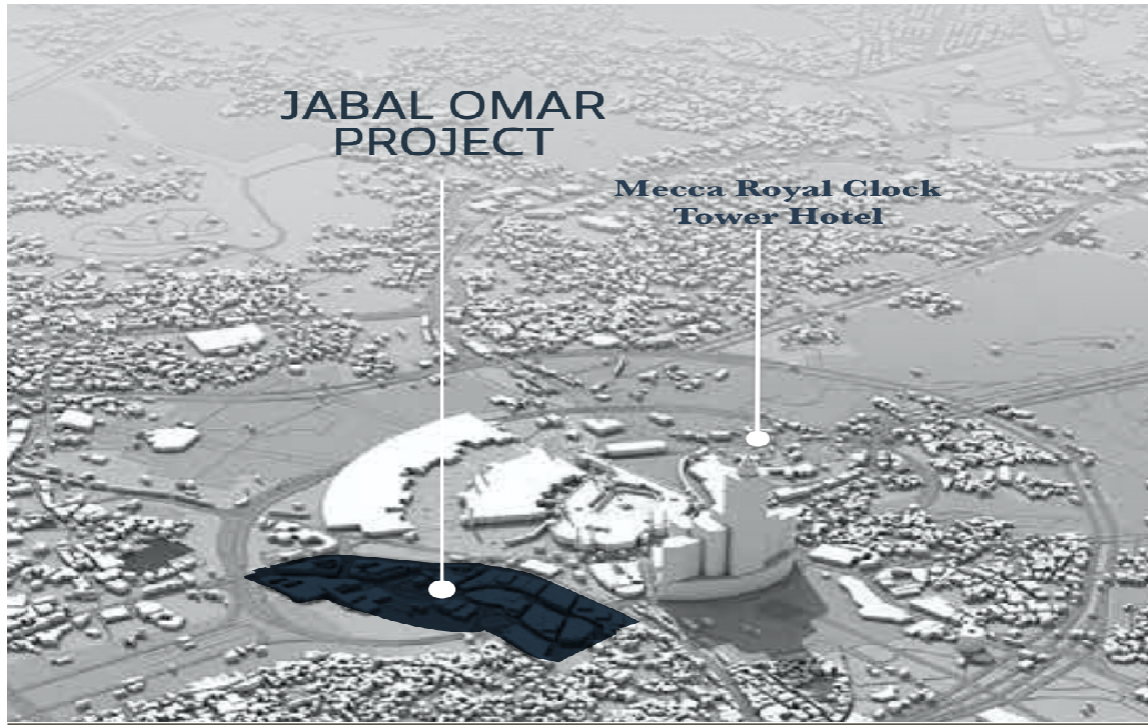


Figure 5 - Jabal Omar Project Location

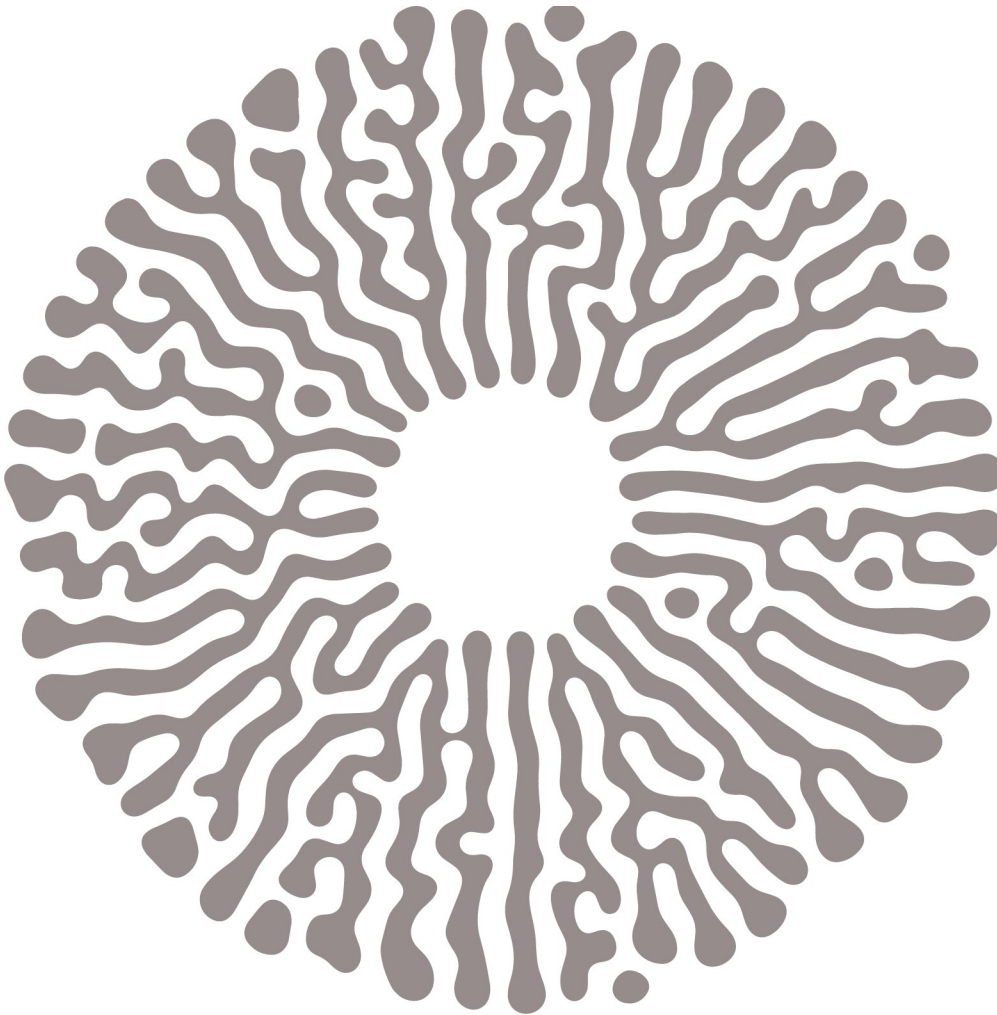

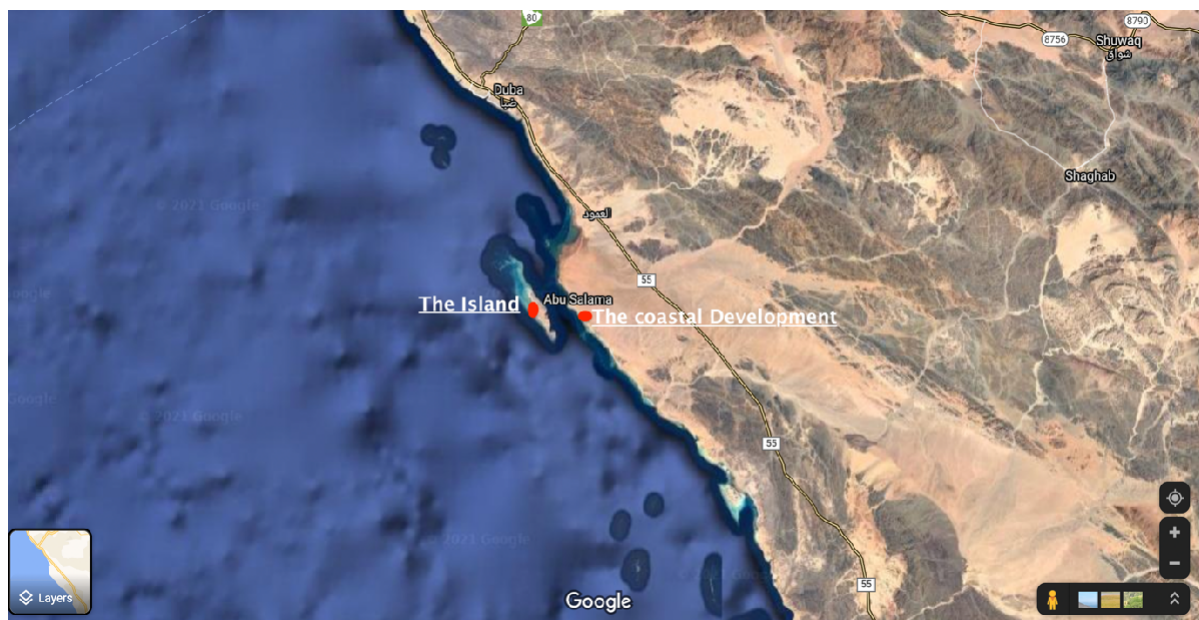


Figure 6- AMAALA location

Owing to the Saudi Kingdom's unique location, the transportation and logistics projects will be fundamental players in achieving the vision 2030. Therefore, generous financing plans will target the development of seaports, airports, roads, trains, logistics facilities.
